

Autumn 2018 Tawny Owls Ourselves

Maths:

This term we will be covering the units; Place Value, Addition and Subtraction, Shape and Money. The children will learn other skills such as multiplication during everyday activities e.g. lining up in two's and counting.

PE:

We will continue to use the Real PE scheme of work throughout the year and they will learn skills such as; Coordination, Static Balance and Dynamic Balance.

Computing:

We will be looking at how to stay safe using a computer and cover the necessary e-safety aspects of the curriculum alongside learning key skills on a computer such as opening and saving a document.

RE:

This will be closely linked to our PSHE sessions on friendship, looking at stories such as; The Deer and the Crow, The Wind and the Moon and David and Jonathon.

Science:

Animals and Humans is our topic this term. We will cover aspects like; hygiene, healthy eating and exercise, basic needs and survival.

PSHE:

All about me, friendships and teamwork are some of the aspects being covered this term.

English:

The children will be developing a variety of writing skills throughout the term including the genres; fiction, instruction, letter and poetry. These will be taught using a range of texts such as; The Traction Man, I love Bugs and How to Wash a Woolly Mammoth.

Reading will be taught through shared reading of the above texts, letters and sounds and guided reading sessions.

Geography:

The children will be exploring the local environment and community.

History:

The children will be looking at Toys from the past and present.

Art and Design Technology:

Portraits are going to be the theme this term. The children will be using a variety of medium to create portraits based on the artists like, Picasso, Paul Klee and Andy Warhol. They will also design and create a fabric face.

Music:

The children will be following the Music Express syllabus. This term we will be exploring duration and pulse and rhythm.
