This is an important update about school attendance for the 2023/24 academic year.

Bridestowe Primary School is working in partnership with parents and local community partners to ensure every child has access to a fantastic education through regular attendance at school.

## A big THANK YOU to all our parents for everything you have done this year to support your child's attendance, despite all the challenges that families face in what we know have been difficult times.

Next academic year, your efforts, working in partnership with the school, will ensure that your child will have the best chance to achieve their academic potential and develop positive relationships with their peers and the adults who are there to support them, this in turn will positively impact their resilience and wellbeing.

Regular attendance (97\% and above) enables your child to:

- access the learning needed to help them make expected progress
- make and develop positive friendships
- access wider opportunities provided by the school
- develop good learning behaviours and life skills

If you are worried about your child/children's attendance, the first port of call is to discuss your concerns with the school directly. Most difficulties relating to absence can be dealt with quickly and promptly by in-school support, and all schools work closely with Early Help, health and the local authority teams who may also be able to help if needed.
