

# BARN OWLS HOME LEARNING

Autumn 1<sup>st</sup> Half Term 2019



Our topics for this term are shown in the diagram in our homework books. Spellings/Reading comprehensions and Times Tables will continue to be tested every Friday morning and the Mental Maths will be tested each Tuesday morning. The regular activities are to be completed by all children every week. We ask all children to complete the core task and bring it to school in the week commencing **Monday 14<sup>th</sup> October** to share with each other. The optional activities are a list of suggestions that you can do if you wish. These can be done at any time and shared with the class.

## Regular activities to do at home every week

- Reading- We expect children to read as much as possible and would like to see them regularly reading at home. The children should be recording this in their reading records.
- Practise weekly spellings or complete reading comprehension.
- Practise for weekly mental maths.
- Practise weekly times tables.

## Core task

**Challenge: Find out about an invention that was produced in the Victorian times.**

Your homework can take any form you wish: presentation, video, information booklet, poster, game, quiz, dance, song etc. This will be delivered to the rest of the class, so be ready to share it.

You will need to bring this in on the week commencing **Monday 14<sup>th</sup> October.**
