School Day

The school day begins at 9.00 am and ends at 3.15pm. Children should be on the playground and ready to be taken into class for registration at 9.00am. If your child arrives in class after this time but before registers close at 9.15am, they will be marked as late. If children arrive in school after registers have closed, then they must be brought to the school office where parents need to sign them in with a reason for being late. Arrival after register closure is marked as unauthorised absence.

Absence and Attendance

Every school has a safeguarding duty to be aware of the reasons for any child's absence. Medical appointments should always, where possible, be booked for outside school hours. If an appointment is arranged for during the school day, the appointment documents must be provided to the school office, preferably in advance. For planned absences other than medical appointments, please ask Mrs Lowden for an Absence Request form. Family holidays in term time will not be authorised.

Owlets

Mrs Baker will not be teaching in Owlets on Monday 17th September as she has a training course. Mrs Harris will cover this absence, and Mrs Lammas will therefore teach Tawny Owls all day.

Behaviour Flow Chart

Teachers have been finalising the behaviour flow chart. They have been listening to, and working with, the children to encourage participation in establishing the school behaviour rules and to create a good understanding of expectations regarding behaviour. The flow chart will be distributed to parents once completed.

Illness

A gentle reminder that children who have suffered with a vomiting and/or diarrhoea bug should not return to school until at least 48hours after the last incident. This is to prevent the spread of infection. Thank you for your continued support.
