Dear Parents and Carers

We welcome you all to the Owlets Class and Bridestowe Primary School. Your child's teachers are Ms Baker (Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday), Mrs Sherring (Thursday, Friday), and Mrs Down will be supporting the class throughout the week.

The Owlets' learning this half term is 'Magnificent Me' where we will be finding out about ourselves and each other. On a Monday we will have 'Wow Weekends' where children can talk about their weekend and bring show and tell in to talk about. This helps to develop children's speaking and listening skills. On Wednesday's children will have PE and Forest School - they will need a full PE kit in school as they will be changing, but do not need a change of clothes for Forest School. They will also have PE on a Friday afternoon.

Children will bring home Read Write Inc reading books in their book bag. Please read with your child 5 times a week and record this in your child's yellow reading diary. Mrs Lammas will be holding a parents talk about this on Friday 23rd September. Children will also bring home a 'pleasure for reading' book and this will be changed in class with the children.

Our Home learning this half term is based on our topic 'Magnificent Me'. Please choose an activity to do with your child that they can share with their peers. Home learning needs to be in school by Thursday 20th October and we will be inviting parents into the class the following day to share the children's learning experiences.
