The children enjoyed comparing local features and plotting their route. Then to the delight of everyone, the afternoon was finished off with a five minute play in the park.

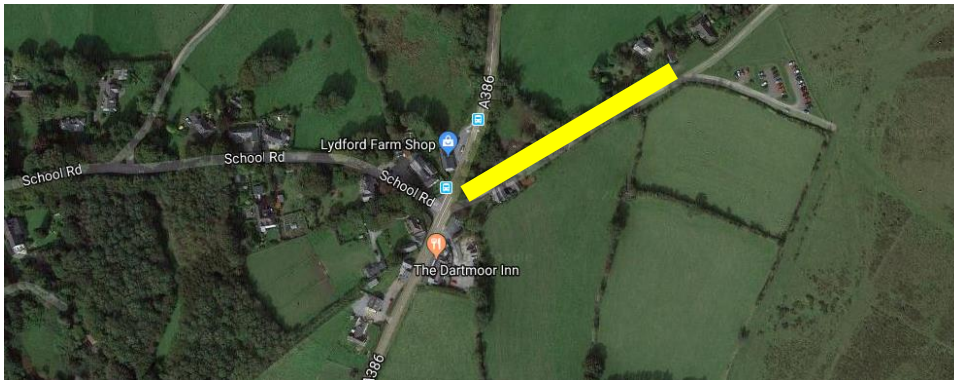
Maths Club
