Ben has also been spotting nature in action—seeing what he thought were tadpoles only for them to transform into newts! The newts are growing well.

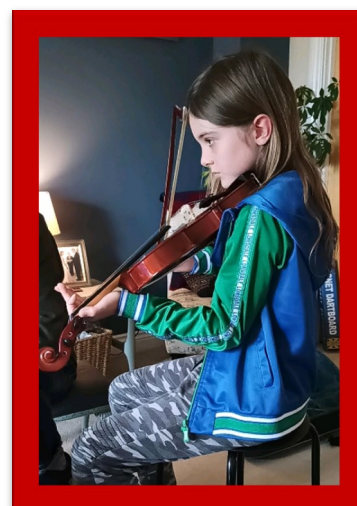
Seth has been busy creating with Lego—some fantastic models!
